

At a glance – Your route to getting qualified

Course duration:

- Access course (Perjuf-H): 4-6 months
- Vocational (first job/trade qualification) course (BOF): 13 weeks

Enrolment:

- Access course (Perjuf-H): Through the Employment Agency/ Job Centre
- Vocational course (BOF): Enrolment possible at any time – no referral necessary. You can contact BZB directly.

Course times:

- Access course (Perjuf-H): 30 hours/week Mo.-Fr.
- Vocational course (BOF): 40 hours/week Mo.-Fr.

Requirements:

- For recognised refugees and people granted asylum
- Also for asylum seekers or tolerated persons who have access to the labour market
- Minimum German knowledge: Level B1
- Age: 25 or less
- Interested in training and qualifying for a construction trade

Access to construction trades for young refugees (Course code: PerjuF-H)

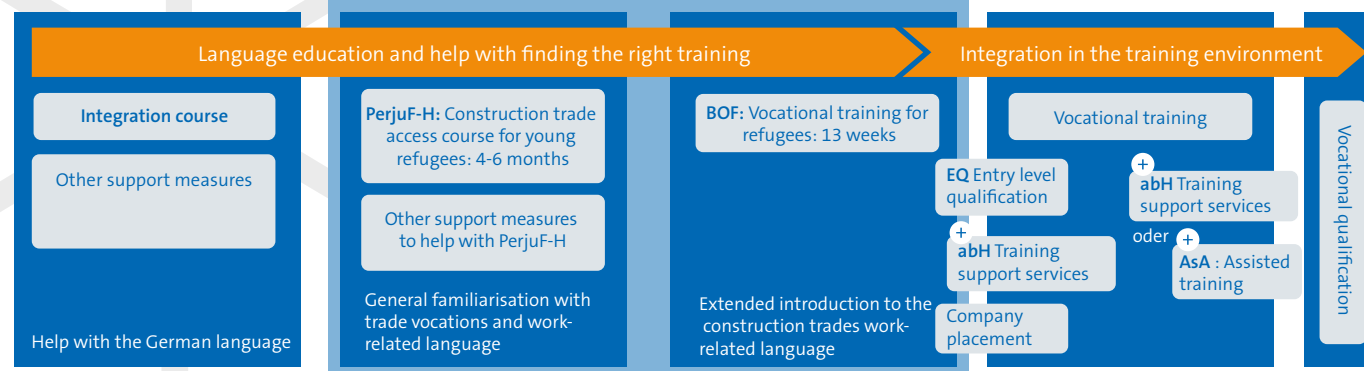
For training and support

- in getting to know the various trades and skill sets in construction
- in understanding how you learn a trade in Germany
- in coping with everyday life
- in building a future for yourself

What will you do in one of our BZB training centres?

- The training course will enable you to try out different trades and discover where your talents and interests lie, e.g. in building, woodworking, metalworking, painting or plastering
- Experience what it means to do a training course and learn a trade
- Further improve your German and learn relevant technical terms
- Get help in coping with your everyday life and in tackling personal problems
- Learn about working in a firm during a company placement

What else?

- You will be given work clothing and personal protective equipment
- Free lunch
- Tickets or money back for travelling on bus and train

How long will the course last?

- 4 to 6 months including a six-week company placement

Who can take part?

- You can take part if you are between 16 and 25 years old and have done an integration course or received educational support *and*
- speak and understand German to a reasonable degree *and*
- are an asylum seeker, tolerated person, asylum grantee or recognised refugee in Germany

Vocational (first job/trade qualification) training for refugees (Course code: BOF)

Benefits

You get 13 weeks of initial training in up to three trades in line with your suitability and likes. During this time, you will get further language training and be supported by our social education workers.

Where to start

Once you have completed the PerjuF-H access course or similar, you will need to get in touch with the BZB contact person as listed.

Programme and content

Workshop days:

- 9 weeks in the BZB workshops
- Development of craft/trade techniques
- Getting to know the German training system
- Development of trade skills
- Preparation for a vocational course at college

Company placement

- Getting to know the host company, its procedures and its employees; duration: 4 weeks
- Use of skills you have learned
- Preparation for a vocational (job qualification) course at college

Vocational language education

- This continues during both the workshop days and the company placement

Support by our social education workers

- Support during the entire training course
- Instruction in social skills related to work
- Support both before and after the company placement
- Support with personal and economic problems

Other benefits

- Free lunch
- Money back for necessary travel costs
- Money back for childcare costs in some cases
