The REFORME PLUS is a 36 months' ERASMUS + project which gathers 7 VET institutions and 6 European countries belonging to the transnational network REFORME, supported by social partners from the construction industry. All the project partners are heads of either national or regional networks and coordinate more than 300 initial and continuing training centers in the construction sector. The REFORME PLUS project aims at enhancing knowledge sharing, cooperation and peer-learning on apprenticeships by identifying good practices, and strengthening mutual learning. The exchanges of practices, experience and know-how and the learning activities will be focused on three themes:

- Improving the image and the attractiveness of apprenticeship in the construction sector emphasizing the success of the careers in this sector.
- Raising the quality of the training: to mutualize and exchange good practices in favor of European cooperation in order to guarantee the quality of the training and of the training paths delivered by the REFORME partners.
- Developing new types of mobility: especially concerning company tutors and mentors; and long term mobility (at least 3 months).

The partnership acknowledge that these three objectives cannot be reached without involving systematically the main actors and vectors of change present in the training centers and in the companies: training managers, trainers, mobility coach and company tutors. This is why the REFORME PLUS project foresees five learning activities, addressed to the managing director, to the trainers, to the mobility coach and to the company tutors. These publics will benefit of 5 workshop in order to develop the transversal competencies which will contribute to the internationalization of their institutions. These activities will be organized on a bilateral or trilateral basis and its results will be capitalized during the transnational meetings of the REFORME PLUS partnership.

Hence, the direct operational objectives and target-groups of our REFORME PLUS project are:

- To strengthen and extend the REFORME network;
- To exchange and mutualize good practices among the network and then disseminate them;
- To enhance and develop the internationalization strategies of the memberships' organizations, that are all VET centers, and the VET centers of our national networks - for those who have one: France, Italy and Spain;
- To develop the mobility actions of the membership's VET centers;
- To professionalize the trainers, teachers and managers of the membership's VET centers.

In order to reach these global and operational goals, the REFORME PLUS project will produce and disseminate at regional, national and European level the following deliverables:

- A video promoting the image of apprenticeship in Europe and the trades of the construction sector, based on infographics or "computer-assisted digital imaging". This facilitates visual thinking by presenting data, charts and graphs illustrating the efficiency of apprenticeship on youth employment.
- Technical notes to provide propositions and fact-oriented contributions to the reflexions on the promotion of apprenticeship and of European mobility of apprentices. These could be double-check communication on the Jean Arthuis report; or documents proposing levers to overcome the obstacles to mobility for apprentices dedicated to European Alliance of Apprenticeship; or to improve the conditions of their development - always from a technical point of view.
- Short guides for the conception and implementation of learning activities and mobility actions dedicated to VET staff: managers, trainers, mobility coach and company tutors.
- A booklet describing the best practices of our VET centers in their process of internationalization.
